We recently received notice of a change in ownership for the Land Use Commission Docket A91-672 C. Brewer, for approximately 20.644 acres of State Land Use District ("SLUD") Agricultural land at Mā'alaea. It is our understanding that the subject property, together with the rest of the parcel, is being conveyed to The Trust for Public Land, a California nonprofit corporation ("TPL"). Following transfer to TPL, TPL will transfer the property to the State of Hawai'i, Department of Land and Natural Resources, Division of Forestry and Wildlife ("DLNR-DOFAW").

Upon completion of conveyance please provide the Land Use Commission ("LUC") with ownership documentation, and specific contact information.

This letter is to inform you that the subject property was converted from SLUD Conservation to Agriculture in 1991, and conditions were imposed on the land.
