Subject: Proposed Urban Rezoning
of Waiakea Homestead Area

The Land Use Commission has initiated a petition to rezone the Waiakea Homestead area from the Agricultural District to the Urban District. The Commission will schedule public hearings sometime during the month of March or April 1971. We will notify you when the hearing date is determined. The area in question generally includes the properties on both sides of Kawaiiani and Haihai Roads between Kupulau and Komohana Streets. A map of the area is enclosed for your information.

I have scheduled a meeting on Tuesday, December 8 at 7 p.m. in the Hawaii County Council Chambers, Hilo, Hawaii, to discuss this proposed rezoning and possible effects. There are many agricultural activities within this area which should be made aware of this pending rezoning action, and of the agricultural dedication procedures that are available under the Land Use Law.

We, therefore, urge that you attend this meeting on December 8th and notify others who may be interested in this matter.
