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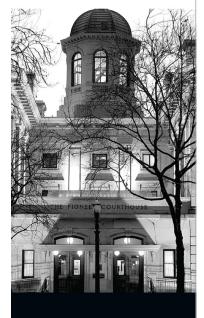

CHAIRMAN GIOVANNI: Thank you, Mr. Hu. 8 the intervenor Ko Olina Community Association 10 represented? 11 MR. CHIPCHASE: Yes, Chair. Good morning. 12 Cal Chipchase and Chris Goodin joining 13 remotely for Ko Olina Community Association and 14 Senator Maile Shimabukuro. 15 CHAIRMAN GIOVANNI: Thank you. 16 intervenor Schnitzer present and who represents him? 17 MS. TAM-SUGIYAMA: Yes, Chair. This is 18 Joyce Tam-Sugiyama and Rihui Yan for Schnitzer. 19 CHAIRMAN GIOVANNI: Thank you. For the County, City and County of Honolulu, who is present 21 please and representing? 22 MR. MR. HU: Jeffrey Hu. So I believe the seven years that we were talking about is in regard to -- or it's more like seven and a half to eight years was in regard to the Waimanalo Gulch. The PVT landfill currently -- we're not sure exactly when it's going to close, but I thought the capacity was probably less than that, currently.

But to answer your question, the new landfill that we're looking to identify and eventually site, that's currently going to be a municipal -- it's going to take in municipal waste and so if the PVT landfill closes and PVT just for everybody's information takes in construction and demolition waste, and so if that closes and if there is no other CMD waste landfill out there, then I guess the city would have to look into whether it has to take in C&D as waste as well, but currently, we're -- I believe the new landfill that we're trying to identify, currently we're only looking at MSW which is municipal solid waste.

COMMISSIONER KAHELE: So what would happen to the construction demolition waste once PVT shuts down? Isn't the city responsible for all the waste that fills through the county or Honolulu?

MR. HU: Jeffrey Hu. I think you're

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right, because the city is probably the last -- you

   know, it's the city's duty, right, to the people to
   figure out what to do, so I think if the city is
 3
   faced with that issue, then I think it's up to the
 5
   city to figure out where to put that C&D waste, so
 6
   you're correct, I think.
