# **BACKGROUND & CONTEXT**

- 2008 Reclassification: Original boundary amendment granted.
- 2019 Decision & Order: Established phased plan with a 6-year deadline for initial phases.
- Project Delays: COVID-19, leadership changes, economic factors, and subdividing the Petition Area.
- **Goal:** Develop a safe, functional campus that serves our students, our church members, and the broader Maui community.

## **ORIGINALVS. REVISED PHASES**

## ORIGINAL (2018-2019)

- Phase I (2019–21): Secure Funding
- Phase 2 (2021–23): Multi-Purpose Bldg
- Phase 3 (2025–27): Classrooms
- Phase 4 (2027–28): Sanctuary (Optional)

## REVISED (2022–PRESENT)

- Phase A (Now–25): Feasibility & Discovery
- Phase B (2025–27): Concept & Design
- Phase C (2027–29): Construction
- Phase D (2029–30): Sanctuary Buildout

# SCHEDULE & COMPLIANCE (CONDITIONS | & 25)

- Original Deadline: Complete first two phases by July 11, 2025.
- Reasons for Delay:
  - Pandemic impacts
  - Transition in church/school leadership
  - Financing complexities and subdividing half the property
- **Commitment:** File a Motion to Amend or Modify to extend deadlines while maintaining compliance.

# **CULTURAL IMPACT & NATIVE SPECIES**

- **CIA Submitted:** Addresses traditional and customary practices, plus historical/cultural resources. The report and analysis is largely identical to the WDV CIA due to proximity.
- Native Flora & Fauna: Potential presence of 'uhaloa, 'ope'ape'a (Hawaiian hoary bat), etc.
- Curriculum Development: Plans to integrate lessons on local ecology and cultural stewardship into our school programs.
- Ka Pa'akai Compliance: Will coordinate with SHPD if we discover unanticipated archaeological or cultural resources.

- Specialized church-school financing and advisory
- Capital campaigns and phased funding approach

- Comprehensive financing strategies for each project phase
- Will submit these details with our Motion to Amend/Modify

## 3. Building Committee & New Staff

- Committee members with expertise in construction, finance, and planning
- Recently expanded administrative support to ensure smooth compliance and project oversight

# **CONDITION NO. 5 – TIAR REQUIREMENT**

 Original Requirement: Revised Traffic Impact Analysis Report (TIAR) after Phase 1.

#### • Why Removal or Amendment?

- Infrastructure Upgrades along Waiale Road/Kuikahi Drive since 2008
- **Modest Enrollment**  $\rightarrow$  Lower traffic impact than once feared

## • Next Steps:

- Incorporate request to remove or scale down Condition No. 5 in our Motion
- Will consider minimal traffic documentation if required by agencies

# **TIMELINE & NEXT STEPS**

## • File Motion to Amend/Modify: before July 11, 2025

- Seek deadline extensions under Conditions I & 25
- Request relief from Condition 5 TIAR obligation

## • Agency Coordination:

- Utilize support from the Office of Planning & Sustainable Development
- Collaborate with County of Maui departments
