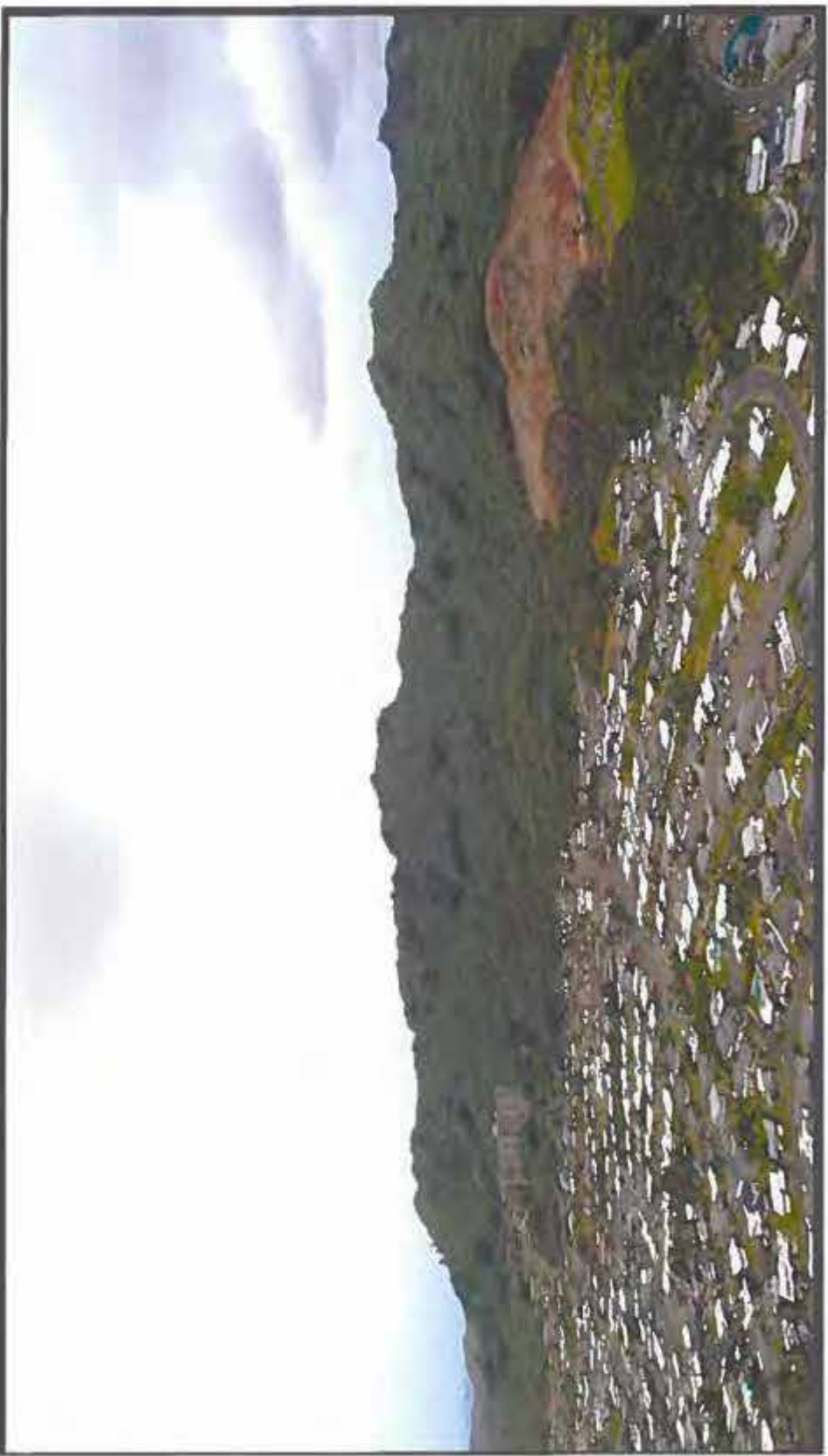


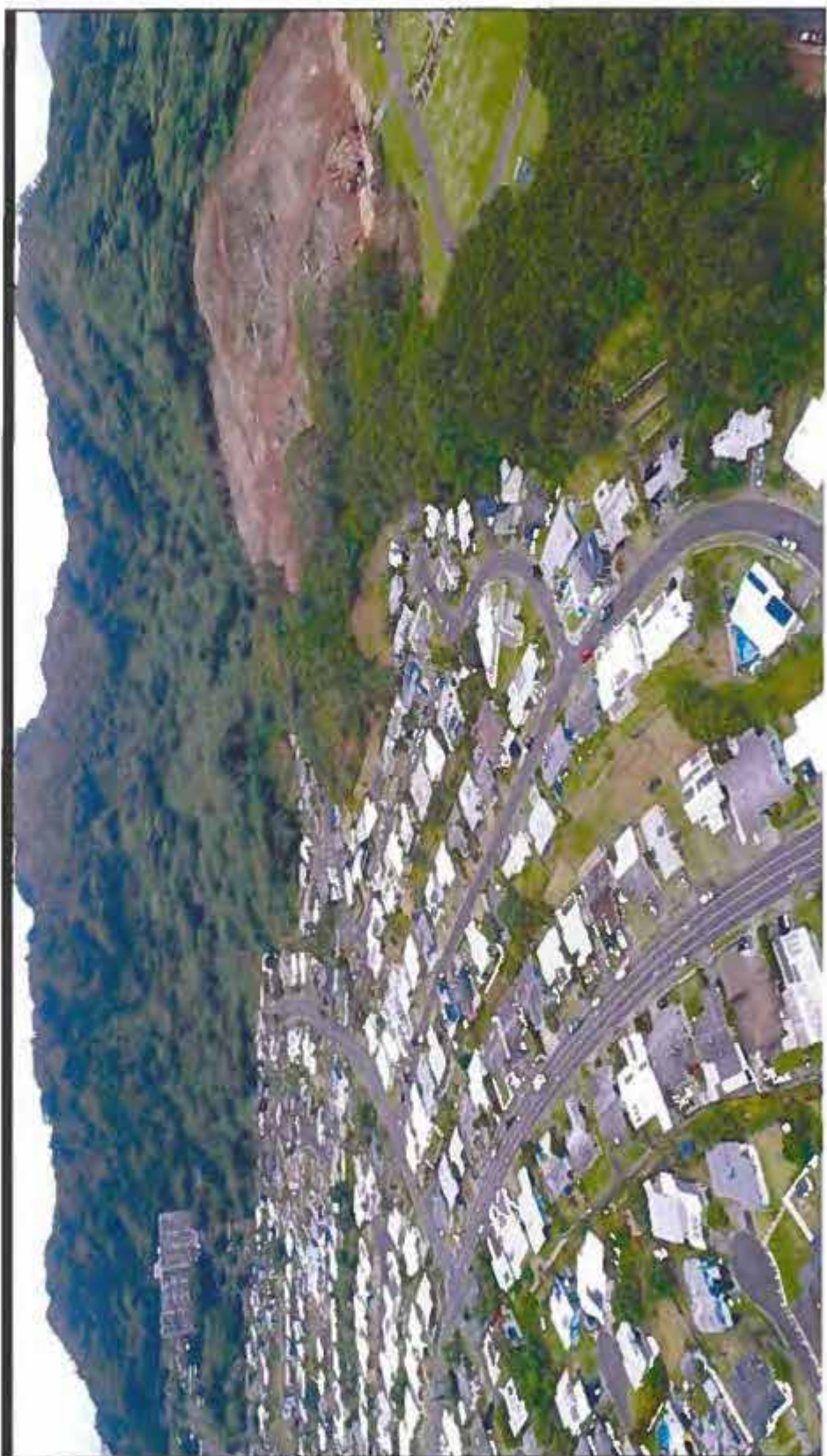

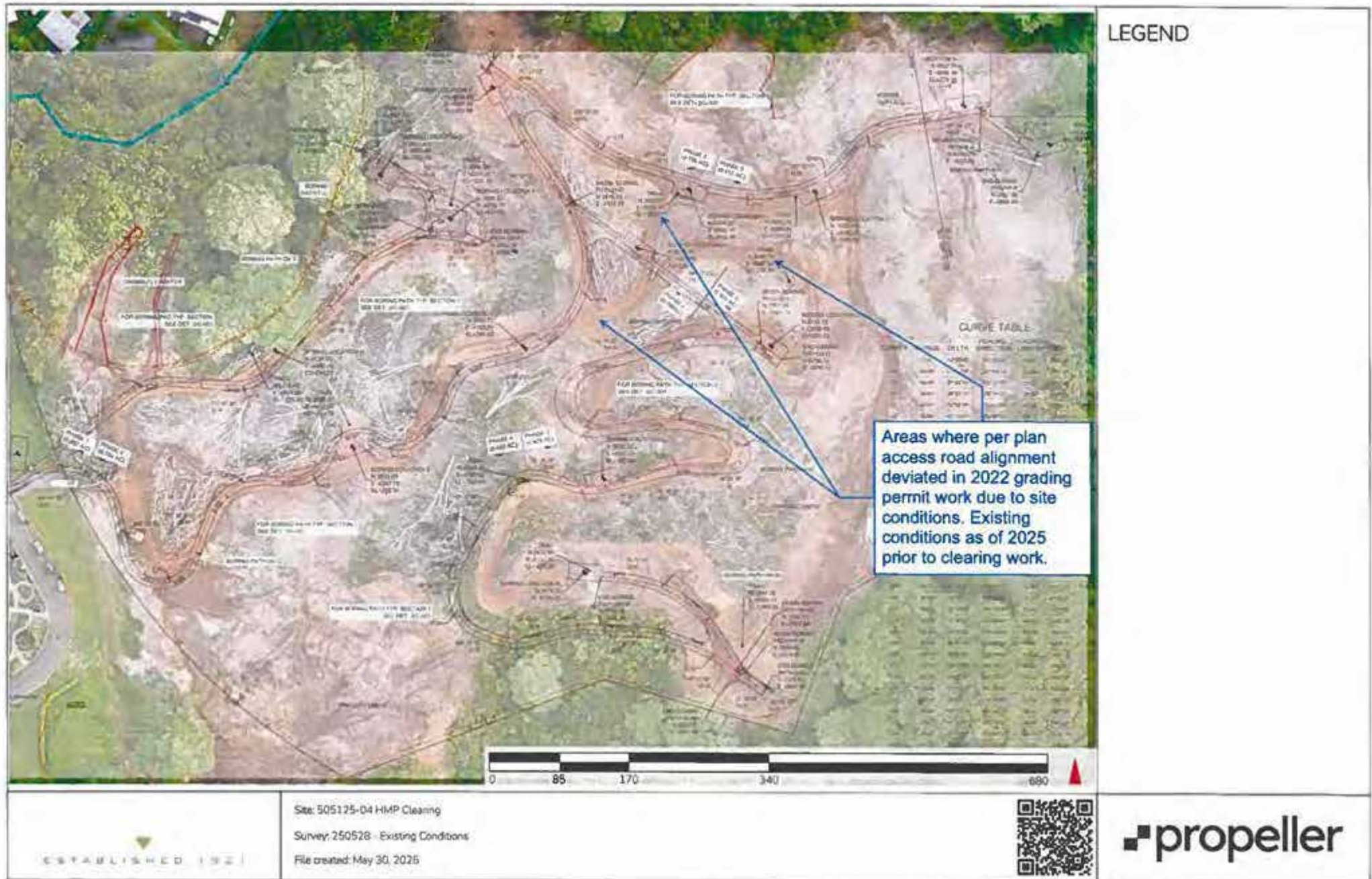
In response to the community complaints to DPP regarding the Hawaiian Memorial Park Expansion project, Goodfellow Bros. has prepared the following package of photo documentation and backup information to address the complaints. Goodfellow Bros. has not excavated or graded any additional access trails within the project limits and only performed tree cutting and clearing during this 2025 work. Goodfellow Bros. used the existing access trails that were installed in 2022 under a grading permit to move heavy equipment through the site to perform the clearing. With removal of the tree canopy, Kaneohe residents can now see parts of the access trails installed in 2022. This is shown in the photo dated 5/7/25 from the SaveKaneohe.com website.

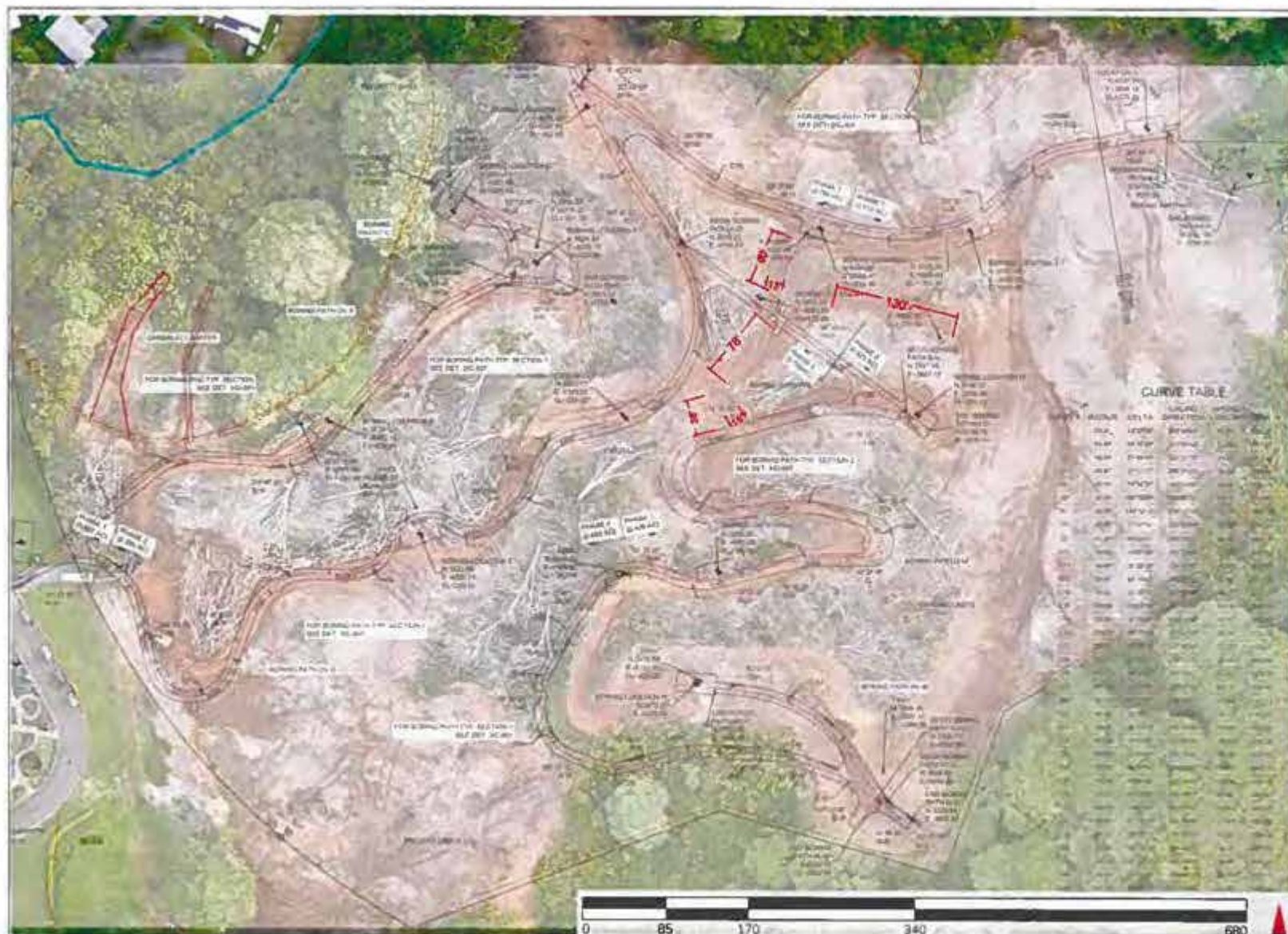
In the attached package a drone flight from 5/28/25 is overlaid onto a plan sheet from the "Hawaiian Memorial Expansion – Geotechnical Exploration" showing the layout of the access trails permitted in the grading permit. This overlay shows that Goodfellow Bros. has not been excavating or grading additional access trails from what was installed in 2022. Also included in the package is several photos taken in 2022 and number correlated to the included plan sheet to show approximate locations through the site. The photos should demonstrate that the vertical cuts visible throughout the site on the access trails should be considered "existing conditions". These vertical cuts were made during the geotechnical exploration phase in 2022 under a grading permit and left in place with the closure of the grading permit. Goodfellow Bros. was not responsible for making these vertical cuts in the clearing work performed in 2025.

Please review the attached documents and photos for clarification.

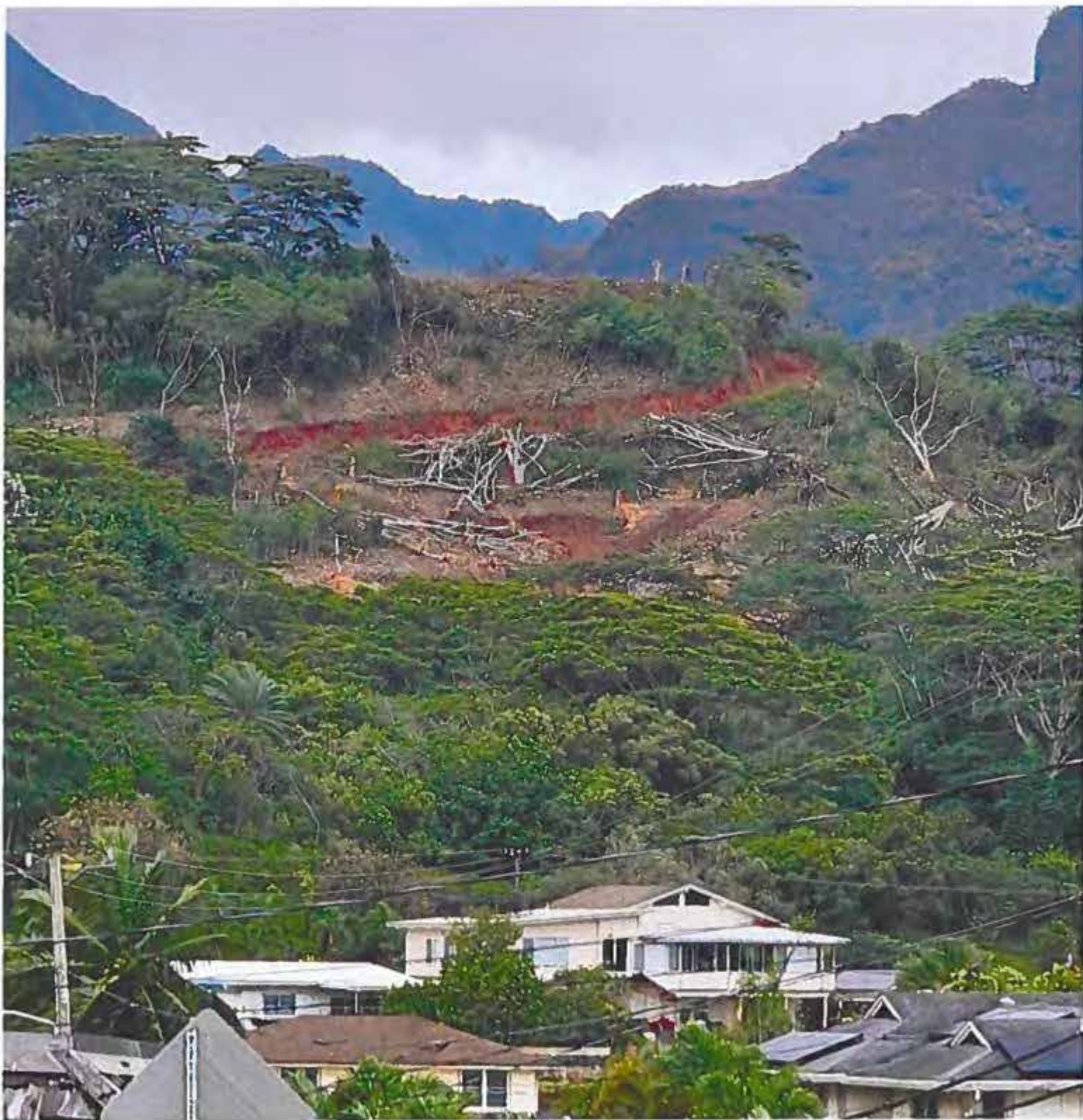

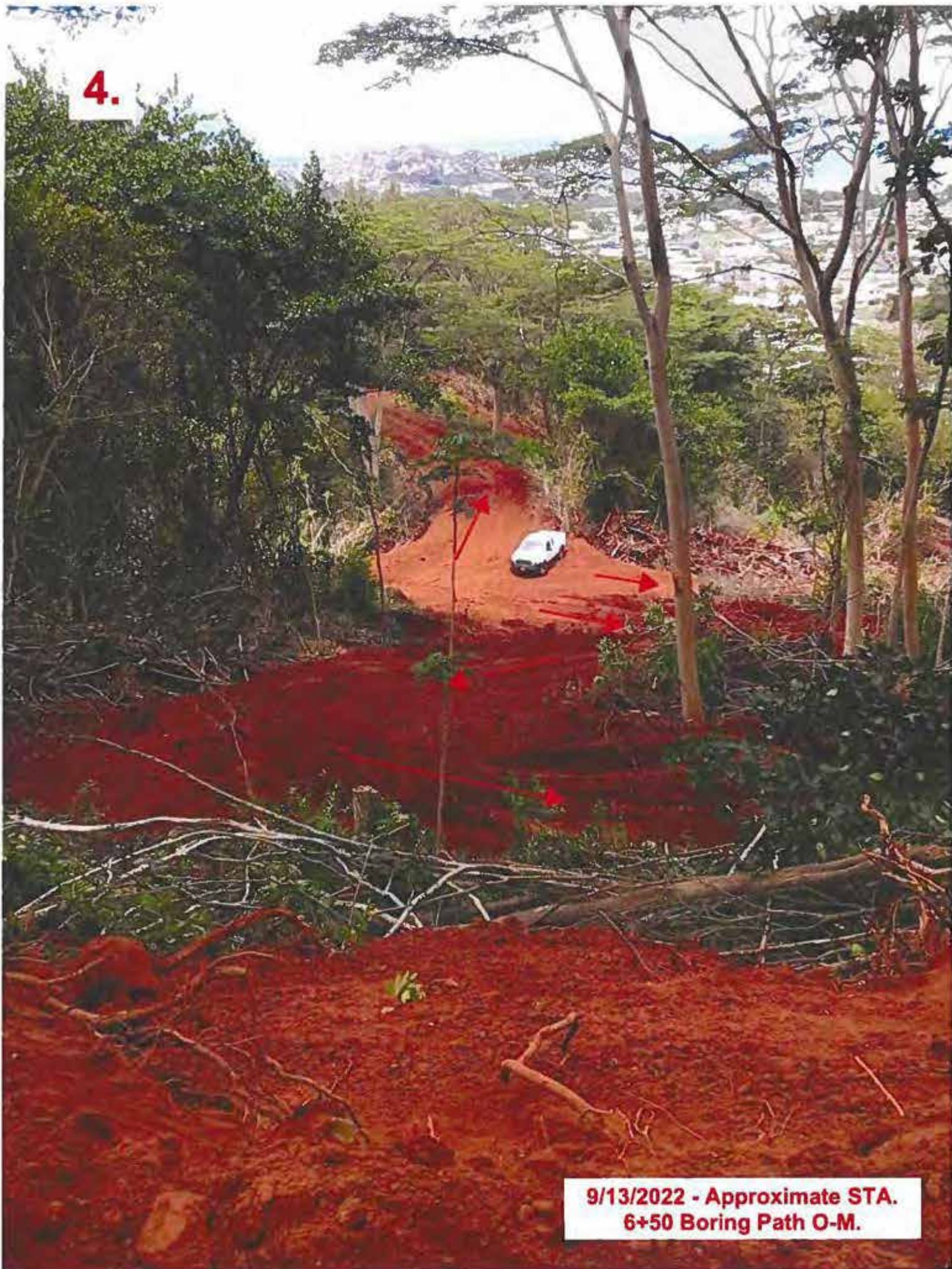
